

Tire Defect Attorney Files Lawsuit Against General Motors After Woman Killed in Car Rollover

HOUSTON, TX August 18, 2010: Rob Ammons of the Ammons Law Firm has filed a lawsuit on behalf of Guadalupe Montana a representative of the late Maria Guadalupe Cabello de Montana, killed after a tire defect caused her car to rollover.

The accident happened after the 1996 Chevrolet Blazer she was driving with her daughter and husband suffered a blowout of the vehicle's left rear tire. The vehicle became uncontrollable, crossed traffic lanes and rolled over on the roadway, coming to rest on its roof.

In the rollover, Maria Guadalupe Cabello de Montana sustained injuries from which she died. Arely Montana de Cabello and Guadalupe Montana were injured but survived.

"We will show the General AmeriTrac tire detreaded and caused the rollover," says Ammons. "The tire was defective an unreasonably dangerous as designed, manufactured and marketed."

Continental Tires, General Motors and the Discount Tire Company of Texas are also named defendants in this lawsuit.
