Below are a few tips that can help keep you safe and avoid a DUI charge:

- **Designate a driver** alternate with friends so one person isn't stuck not having fun
- **Hail a cab** call one for round trip or leave your vehicle, call a taxi and return the next morning to pick up your vehicle
- Stay put spend the night at a friend's house to avoid driving drunk
- Walk home if you live close, walk to and from where you will be drinking; make sure to stay in well-lit areas and travel with a friend for added safety
- **Buy a breathalyzer machine** it can help you make a decision, especially if you are close to or over the legal limit
- **Fix your car** officers must have a reason to pull you over other than just being suspicious of a DUI; ensure car and lights are in proper working order
