If a debilitating disease prevents you from working, you may be entitled to receive Social Security disability (SSDI) benefits. The Social Security Administration (SSA) has a list of the diseases and conditions that qualify for SSDI benefits. These conditions are listed in the SSA blue book. These diseases and conditions include but are not limited to:

- \*Cancer
- \*Chronic heart failure
- \*Blindness
- \*Hearing impairment
- \*Cystic fibrosis
- \*Chronic liver disease
- \*Kidney disease
- \*Parkinson's disease
- \*Multiple sclerosis
- \*HIV infection
- \*and many others

Both physical and mental illnesses are included in the SSA list. While the list is comprehensive, it is not exhaustive. In order to qualify for SSDI benefits, you do not have to have a condition listed in the SSA blue book. Likewise, all those who have the listed conditions are not guaranteed benefits. Claimants qualify for SSDI benefits by demonstrating that their impairments are sufficiently severe to prevent them from working.
