

# Tips for Finding the Best San Antonio Court Reporting Services

## Ask, and You Shall Receive

Choosing the right <u>San Antonio court reporter</u> from a long list of unknown quantities isn't an easy task, but by asking a lot of questions, and more importantly, the right questions, can help an attorney make the right choice for their specific needs. Some of the areas that an attorney should inquire about are:

- What Services Do They Offer?: Twenty years ago, this wouldn't have been nearly as important as it is today, but with the onslaught of technological advances that have evolved the field of court reporting, things have changed considerably. These days, choosing the best court reporter often means determining which one can provide the most useful services. Does the court reporter or <u>litigation</u> <u>support</u> firm offer realtime court reporting? Do they provide access to a handy online transcript repository? Do they provide videoconferencing or other legal video services? Once you know all the tools that each will bring to the table, find out what is considered standard for their transcript packages, and what services will result in an additional fee being charged.
- How Well Do They Communicate?: Accurate court reporting is influenced substantially by the court reporters ability to communicate. If they are unable to communicate smoothly and effectively with you on the phone, how well will they be able to handle transcribing <u>depositions</u>?
- Are They Experienced?: An attorney is best served by a court reporter who not only has a solid background of experience, but a healthy amount of experience in the particular field the attorney requires for that particular case. Ask for references, and do the due diligence required by checking them.
- A Time and a Place For Everything: An attorney should always check to make sure that the court reporter is available to work at any and all locations required for the case. The scheduling considerations should be taken into account as well. Can the court reporter be where they need to be, when they need to be there, in order to get the job done?
