## ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR INTERLOCK DEVICE IN LIEU OF LICENSE SUSPENSION

The Defendant, by Counsel, Dan Hancock, has filed a Petition For Interlock Device in Lieu of License Suspension. The Court having determined that there was probable cause to believe the Defendant has violated I.C. 9-30-5 or I.C. 14-15-8, and the Defendant having moved the Court to permit the Interlock Device (C.I.I.D.) In lieu of a license suspension pursuant to I.C. 9-30-6-8(d), the Court now finds that the Defendant shall be permitted to operate a motor vehicle as and when permitted by law, but only when it is equipped with a functioning Certified Ignition Interlock Device (C.I.I.D.)

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Defendant be permitted to operate a motor vehicle(s), but only when it is equipped with a functioning Certified Ignition Interlock Device (C.I.I.D.) under I.C. 9-30-8.

DEFENDANT IS FURTHER ORDERED to file each of his/her C.I.I.D. installation receipts with this Court immediately upon the installation of a C.I.I.D.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant shall, at all times, maintain a copy of this Order in each vehicle he/she is then operating.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Bureau of Motor Vehicles shall permit the Defendant to operate a motor vehicle so long as:

- 1. A functioning C.I.I.D. is installed in each vehicle the Defendant operates when he/she is operating the vehicle, and
- 2. The Defendant obeys all laws and does not violate any traffic law, and
- 3. The Defendant does not violate any terms or conditions of the Defendant's release on bond or recognizance release.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall remain in effect until the BMV is notified by this Court that the criminal charges in this case against the Defendant have been resolved, or upon further Order of this Court.

The undersigned Defendant has read, or had read to them, and understands and agrees to comply with this Order at all times.
