## If Your Baby Suffers Cerebral Palsy from Medical Malpractice a Birth Injury Lawyer May Be Able to Help

You may or may not have heard of cerebral palsy lawsuits before. These are handled by a <u>birth injury lawyer</u> that specializes in representing the children and the family affected. These lawsuits are intended to provide money for the child to pay for their care into the future and help the family pay for that care, as well. You may be able to get assistance from one of these lawyers if your child was born with a brain injury due to medical malpractice.

## **Understanding Malpractice**

Doctors have different rules than regular people in the execution of their job. They do, however, have certain legal obligations that are common with many different types of professionals. When they do not live up to the requirement that they deliver competent care to their patients, they can be sued for malpractice.

Understand that malpractice lawsuits are not only important to the families involved, they are also frequent bogeymen for politicians. These lawsuits, however, end up helping families who have been wronged by a physician in many different ways.

The first and most obvious way these lawsuits help families is by providing money that can be used for necessary care. If your child has cerebral palsy, the level of care you're able to give them is, for better or worse, directly tied to how much money you have. Not too surprisingly, the best and most effective forms of care are usually the most expensive forms of care, as well.

Malpractice lawsuits are not intended to provide an easy way for families to cash out on a tragedy. They are intended to hold physicians responsible for what they do or do not do and they are sometimes the only way that a family has a realistic chance of providing their child with the type of care that they deserve.

## Talking to a Lawyer

If you need to know whether or not a lawyer can help you, you should just go ahead and schedule an appointment with a lawyer. Look for a lawyer who works on contingency, because this means that your initial consultation will be free. It also means you won't have to pay them if you lose your claim. If your child has cerebral palsy and it was the result of medical negligence, an attorney may be able to help you in very meaningful ways and you should contact one as soon as possible.
