Re: Read Discovery from Prosecution

Dear :

Please read the enclosed police records which are called Discovery from the Municipal Prosecutor. Please write down any inaccurate statements or comments and mail them back to me. Please do not call in the inaccurate details.

If you plead guilty or are found guilty, the judge at the time of sentencing always has several options including but not limited to jail, probation, community service, restitution and substance abuse counseling. The judge will also review any letters or documents that are submitted to the Court on your behalf. Please prepare and mail to my office a list of 15 reasons why the judge should not impose the maximum penalties or fines within 10 days of receiving this letter.

For clients that have multiple prior violations, we recommend very strongly that you obtain letters from relatives or other individuals who know you who would be willing to write to the Court to indicate that there should not be incarceration. These letters should set forth favorable aspects regarding your life and your future. They should point out some of the good traits that you possess. They should also feel free to put any other reasons why the Court should impose the minimum penalties. Bring these letters to the court. These letters are for your benefit and these instructions should be followed.

If the Court is going to suspend your driver's license, you should get a ride to court. Most Judges will no longer issue a temporary license to drive home. If you have any questions, please contact my office.
