Storage:

- If materials stored in tiers: stack them, rack them, block them, or interlock them
- Store materials more than 6 feet from any hoistway or interior floor opening
- Store materials more than 10 feet from any exterior walls that do not extend above the top of the stored materials

Materials Placed on Public Streets:

- Well guarded
- Suitable warning signs
- Lighted at night

Handling:

- Inspect all rigging equipment for material handling prior to use on each shift
- Keep aisles and passageways clear
- Alloy steel chain slings have a permanently affixed durable identification
 - States size, grade, capacity and manufacturer
- Hooks, rings, oblong links, pearshaped links, coupling links, and other attachments must have a rated capacity of at least that of the chain
 - Cannot use job or shop hooks and links or makeshift fasteners
- U-bolt clips should be properly spaced and installed when forming eyes in wire rope

Disposal:

- Dispose waste materials properly
