Summary

The chapter 7 Trustee for Ausam Energy Corporation and Noram Resources, Inc. sued Ausam/Noram's pre-petition creditor, Huff Energy Fund LP and Barry Borak, a former director of Ausam, for breach of fiduciary duty and civil conspiracy. The Court has already dismissed most of the claims against Huff on the basis of *res judicata*. The court now grants in part and denies in part a second motion to dismiss on the basis of judicial estoppel and *res judicata*.
