Agency Has the Burden of Proving Exemption for FOIL Request

The New York Court of Appeals held that the Freedom of Information Law carries the presumption of access to records. The Court held in Matter of Data Tree, LLC v. Romaine that the Suffolk County Clerk, which claimed the requested documents were exempt from disclosure, "carries the burden of demonstrating that the exemption applies to the FOIL request." Municipalities and State Agencies can no longer merely claim an exemption and refuse to disclose records. This case clearly states that the Courts will place the burden on the agency to demonstrate any exemption, which the Court said should be "narrowly interpreted" actually applies.
