UNION INSURANCE OBTAINS DISMISSAL OF HURRICANE COVERAGE ACTION BY BANKRUPTCY COURT & IS AWARDEI ATTORNEYS' FEES

Recently, Union Insurance Company successfully defended, and recovered its attorneys' fe an adversary proceeding in bankruptcy court brought by the debtor in possession for bui damages allegedly caused by Hurricane Ike. *Gulf Freeway Plaza, LLC v. Union Insur Company*; Adversary Proceeding No. 10-03378; in the United States Bankruptcy Court fo Southern District of Texas, Houston Division. Union successfully defended the adve proceeding by obtaining a dismissal of all claims against it. Union sought dismissal on the that the debtor should be judicially estopped from pursing the adversary proceeding becar failed to disclose the claim to the bankruptcy court in its schedules, because it caused a reentity to bring a lawsuit outside of the bankruptcy against Union, and because the corp representative of both entities gave conflicting testimony in the two lawsuits regarding claim.

In the adversary proceeding, during a hearing to obtain a turnover of insurance proceeds he the lienholder, the corporate representative testified that the building had been repaired and ready to be placed back into service, and presented the court with supporting projected in schedules. In the non-bankruptcy proceeding, the same person (acting as corp representative for a related entity) testified that the building required millions in repair and t was not fit to be used for any purpose. After hearing the evidence obtained in both suitabankruptcy court ordered the adversary proceeding dismissed and awarded Union its cost attorneys' fees for having to defend the action.
