- 7 1. The Motion is GRANTED.
- 8 2. An Order for Relief be, and hereby is, entered against the Debtor, without prejudice  
9 to the Debtor's Motion to Dismiss Involuntary Petition or, in the Alternative, to Transfer Venue.
- 10 3. The case is hereby converted to a case under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
