Houston Lawyer Believes Trial Strategy Critical for Big Verdict Result

July 27, 2010 Houston, Tx.: The recent record verdict by a Harris county jury of 82.5 million dollars for the family of a man killed in <u>an explosion at a natural gas processing</u> <u>plant</u> is the result of specific trial strategy, says one Houston attorney.

<u>Board certified personal injury attorney Rob Ammons</u> helped the jury to see company that constructed, engineered and installed a Cleburne natural gas processing plant was negligent in the death of a Mineral Wells, Texas man. Hanover Compression LP, now known as Exterran Energy Solutions LP of Houston was ordered to pay \$82.5 million dollars in compensatory damages to the deceased's family, together with Quicksilver Resources Inc., the owner of the plant that was found partly negligent.

"There were a variety of strategies that were used in this case," Says Ammons. "Number one was to introduce the jury to the decedent, to Josh Petrie. And he was just a wonderful young man. But we also wanted to show the jury (and we did) the incentives that the companies have, and where their priorities were, fact that they did literally place their profit, or their pocketbook, over the safety of workers. And that they made decisions that which knowingly compromised safety."

Ammons says other factors contributed to the success of the case as well, including jury visualization. "We had a furnace that exploded because a company did not meet its obligation to comply with the safety standard. So, through a computer-aided animation, we showed how and why the furnace exploded, as it was installed by this company. And we also showed what would have happened, under the same circumstances, if the safety standard had been followed."
