Events This Month: A Symposium on the Changing Landscape of Energy Needs

On November 5, Tom Burton and Sahir Surmeli, Chair and Co-chair, of the Energy & Clean Technology Practice at Mintz Levin; Brian Bolster, Manager Director of Clean Technology and Renewables/Power at Goldman Sachs; and Kelly Gawlik, Director of Corporate Issues Practice at Weber Shandwick, were the featured speakers at Mintz Levin's panel discussion, "Getting Ready for the IPO Spotlight." The speakers discussed the current IPO market and opportunities for energy and clean-tech companies. Boston College held an energy symposium titled, "Energy: From the Last to the Next 150 Years" on October 25. Tom Burton moderated the panel, "Balancing Energy needs and Climate Change in the 21st Century." After a keynote address by Senator Ed Markey, David A. Deese, Professor of Political Science at Boston College, David A. Wirth, Professor and Director of International Programs at Boston College Law School, and Joseph E. Aldy, Assistant Professor of Public Policy at the Harvard Kennedy School, discussed the future of international and domestic energy policy.

On October 17, Cleantech Open Northeast held its awards and gala ceremony, where NBD Nanotechnologies of Somerville, Massachusetts and Sealed of Astoria, New York were among four regional winners. They will represent the Northeast at the Cleantech Open Global Forum in San Jose, California from November 20 – 21 where they will compete with other environmental and energy technology firms across the nation for the National Grand Prize of \$200,000 in cash and services. More than 300 people including entrepreneurs, business leaders, and public officials from across the Northeast region's clean-tech community attended the October gala.

Washington Update: Water Reform Is Passed and

Greenhouse Gas Regulations Face the Supreme Court

With the federal government shutdown and the threat of default, Washington, DC focused on budget matters for most of October. Energy technology news came from non-governmental sources. The International Panel on Climate Change released the summary of its *Fifth Assessment Report*, which found that average surface temperatures have risen 1.5 degrees Fahrenheit since the industrial revolution. Of the scientists who wrote the report, 95% to 100% are certain that human activity is one driver of this change; by comparison, in 2007, only 66% to 90% of the authors of the Panel's *Fourth Assessment Report* were certain.

Once Washington reopened, the House approved the Water Resources Reform and Development Act. Because the Senate passed the bill's counterpart in May, the two houses now need to negotiate compromise language. If an agreement occurs, it will be the first time since 2007 that a water infrastructure bill has passed. The House and Senate have also passed versions of the Farm Bill, which has now gone to committee for formal negotiations.

The third version of Shaheen-Portman is nearing introduction in the Senate, but many agree that Majority Leader Harry Reid (D-NV) will not move the bill without having 60 votes to override any filibusters. Senator Ed Markey (D-MA) plans to introduce an RES/EERS bill that will establish a federal renewable electricity standard for retail electricity suppliers and a federal energy efficiency standard for electricity and natural gas suppliers.

The Supreme Court has agreed to hear a major case concerning the Environmental Protection Agency's greenhouse gas regulations, specifically whether the EPA can regulate emissions from stationary sources like power plants under the Clean Air Act. The case is a sequel to *Massachusetts v. Environmental Protection Agency* (2007), where the EPA was ordered to set regulations should they find evidence that greenhouse gases from cars endangered public health. When they eventually found such evidence and set regulations, industry groups challenged them on the merits of the research methods employed to reach the critical conclusions. These complaints were unanimously rejected by the US Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, though the Supreme Court accepted six petitions for review of the rejection, including *Utility Air Regulatory Group v. Environmental Protection Agency*. As the president tries to use existing executive power to implement his climate agenda, the Supreme Court will play an important role in the regulatory process as environmental and business groups sue the EPA.

Even with the shutdown, the Department of Energy released a report, authored by the Navigant Consortium, titled, "U.S. Offshore Wind Market and Economic Analysis." The report shows that 11 offshore wind projects representing 3,824 MW of capacity are currently in an advanced stage of development. Of note is the Block Island Wind Farm that is a part of the Deepwater Wind project. The 30-megawatt offshore farm, which will be entirely in Rhode Island waters, will produce enough power for 17,000 homes. Construction of the project is set to begin in 2015.

In a final piece of news, Ron Binz withdrew his name from consideration for the post of Federal Energy Regulatory Chairman. He faced opposition from most Republican and some Democratic members of the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee because they viewed Binz as too "anti-coal." Some replacement candidates being considered Arkansas Public Service Commission Chairman Colette Honorable and current Federal Energy Regulatory Commission members Cheryl LaFleur and John Norris.
