#### I. Certificate of Need program

A. AL2013-060, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc., d/b/a Fresenius Medical Care Foley, Foley, AL: Proposes to expand by adding an additional six hemodialysis stations to the existing facility consisting of nine hemodialysis stations and one isolation station.

B. <u>AL2013-061</u>, <u>Renal Treatment Centers-Southeast</u>, <u>LP</u>, <u>d/b/a Jewel Dialysis</u>, <u>Bessemer</u>, <u>AL</u>: Proposes to add two hemodialysis stations at its current location consisting of seven hemodialysis stations and one isolation stations

C. <u>AL2013-062</u>, Flor Dialysis, LLC, d/b/a Steel City Dialysis Birmingham, AL: Proposes to add two hemodialysis stations at its current location consisting of seven hemodialysis stations and one isolation station.

D. <u>AL2013-063</u>, <u>RAI Care Centers of Alabama</u>, <u>LLC</u>, <u>Jacksonville</u>, <u>AL</u>: Proposes to add four hemodialysis stations and two home training stations to the existing 12-station facility. Opposition: None

**E.** <u>AL2013-064, DCI Evergreen, Evergreen, AL</u>: Proposes to add two stations to the existing 10 stations, one of which is an isolation station for hepatitis B surface antigen positive patients, for a total of 12 stations.

The Board voted to allow the applicant to temporarily add two stations to its existing facility while another area facility is shut down for renovations. Once the renovations of the neighboring facility are complete, the applicant must take the additional two stations out of service because the State Health Plan does not show a need for the additional stations in this county.

**F.** <u>AL2013-065, DCI Mitylene Park, Montgomery, AL</u>: Proposes to add one home training station to the existing 16 stations, one of which is an isolation station.

**G.** AL2013-066, Village at Cook Springs, LLC, Pell City, AL: Proposes to establish a 28-bed specialty care assisted-living facility on the campus of Village East by relocating 26 SCALF beds from the Village at Cook Springs, 15 authorized by CON 2623-SCALF, 11 existing beds, and adding two new beds.

H. <u>AL2013-067</u>, <u>Renal Treatment Centers-Southeast</u>, <u>LP</u>, <u>d/b/a North Jefferson Dialysis</u>, <u>Birmingham</u>, <u>AL</u>: Proposes to establish and operate a new ESRD facility in north Jefferson County consisting of two existing in-center hemodialysis stations to be relocated from DaVita's
