

## 2012 Maximum Compensation Rate is \$803.00

The Florida Department of Financial Services provided an annual increase in the weekly compensation rate that injured employees are paid if placed on a no work status by an authorized workers' compensation doctor. If <u>placed on a no-work status</u>, inured workers are eligible to collect indemnity benefits (lost wage checks) which are calculated at 66 2/3% of an injured workers' average weekly wage. These benefits are called Temporary Total Disability benefits.

The maximum weekly amount that an injured worker can receive if placed on a no work status is \$803.00, if the injury occurred in 2012. The maximum weekly compensation rate in 2011 was \$782.00.
