Divorce proceedings often get ugly, but they rarely get as public as is the case in the current Arizona divorce case of Chris and Alena Simcox.

Most recently, Simcox has been publically supporting and advising Arizona Senator John McCain's senatorial competition J.D. If one had looked into Simcox's history, he would have seen that his 2 previous marriages included accusations of molestation, violence due to an alleged "mental breakdown" and also a 2004 conviction of bringing a firearm into a state park.

We will try to update you in a timely manner when more details of this divorce case emerge, including whether Simcox is granted his requested joint <u>custody</u> of the couples' young children, ages 2 and 3.
