**Decision by Court.** This action came to trial before the Court, Honorable Patrick Michael Duffy, District Judge presiding. The issues have been tried and a decision has been rendered.

**IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that judgment be entered for Plaintiff, Hollingsworth

Funds, Inc. in the amount of \$19,152,165.00 plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of the Order. It is further **ORDERED** that judgment be entered for Plaintiff, James Simons, in the amount of \$326,700.00, plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of this Order. It is further **ORDERED** that judgment be entered for Plaintiffs, Dorothy McLeod Rhodes and Helen McLeod Brown, in the amount of \$11,802,926.00, plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of this Order. It is further **ORDERED** that judgment be for Plaintiff, The McLeod Lumber Company, in the amount of \$13,684,911.00, plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of this order. It is further **ORDERED** that judgment be entered for Plaintiff, Darlington Veneer, in the amount of \$8,214,737.00 (the sum of \$2,394,507.00 in the diminution of the Darlington Veneer Island Tract and the \$5,820,230.00 in diminution of the Darlington Veneer Mainland Tract), plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of this Order. It is further **ORDERED** that judgment be entered for Plaintiff, Frank O'Brien, in the amount of \$102,438.00, plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of this order. It is further **ORDERED** that judgment be entered for Plaintiff, Barry Marsh, in the amount of \$1,924,400.00, plus 8% interest from the date of flooding to the date of this Order.
