Specialized legal experience in the subject matter at issue is vital; while more generalized experience may not translate into value for your concerns. Get into the details when interviewing an attorney. The more details you share about your legal matter, the greater opportunity for insight about the lawyer's ability to handle your legal needs.

There are many factors to consider when hiring outside counsel in addition to those listed above. But perhaps the most important is something that is often overlooked. Put simply, make sure the attorney you intend to hire is someone you can see yourself working with. The attorney-client relationship is unique and personal. While you're not looking for a friend, you do need to be comfortable with the attorney's style and method of communicating. Although you may find a highly skilled lawyer who's a perfect match in terms of expertise, the relationship will suffer if you can't get along.
