PURPOSE/REASON

OUR INCREASED USAGE OF THE INTERNET AFFORDS INDIVIDUALS, BOTH THOSE ACTIVELY PLACING THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION ONLINE AND THOSE HAVING THEIR PERSONAL INFORMATION TRAVEL ONLINE THROUGH THIRD PARTY NETWORKS LESS AND LESS PERSONAL PRIVACY. Whether web users and non-users alike appreciate the situation, most users are having information about their identity and habits collected, collated, and disseminated by various organizations, entities, and individuals.

Because statutes and regulations control the collection and dissemination of personal and business data, it is important for any organizations collecting data to have a well-defined written Internet privacy policy, including a notice of what data is being collected, a choice to opt-out of such collection, access to the data by the particular individual, and security to prevent unauthorized misappropriation or dissemination of the data.
