

Lexus 'Don't Buy' Warning Is Lifted

In a bit of good news for Toyota, finally, Consumer Reports magazine has dropped the "Don't Buy" warning from the 2010 Lexus GX460 SUV. This follows a dealer update to the software controlling the vehicle's electronic stability control system.

Toyota had stopped sales of the GX460 after the "Don't Buy" warning was issued last month. The warning was due to concerns about vehicle rollover in high-speed turns.
