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Automatic Import Licensing Requirement Remains in 2010: Improved or Not?

On 28 May 2010, the Ministry of Industry and Trade ("MOIT") issued Circular No. 24/2010/TT-BCT ("Circular No. 24"), replacing the regulations on automatic import licensing previously set out in Circular No. 17/2008/TT-BCT dated 12 December 2008 ("Circular No. 17") from 12 July 2010. Circular No. 24, contrary to the expectation of a lot of enterprises, mostly upholds the widely criticised regulations on the application of automatic import licensing to a number of goods items under Circular 17, and even lengthens the list of goods items being subject to the extensive rules. The continuation of the system again raises the major issue regarding its compatibility with the obligations under WTO's agreements which Vietnam had signed three years ago, especially those related to the WTO Import Licensing Agreement ("ILA").

More goods subject to automatic import licensing requirement

Circular No. 24 adds more items to the list of goods subject to automatic import licensing requirements. The initial list included products such as plastics, cosmetics, ceramics and glassware, certain iron and steel products; nuclear, certain electronics products including TVs, vehicles, and furniture. The additional goods include raw foods and edible products, drinks and beverages, and clothing and footwear, toys, etc. For more information, please see the Appendix below.

Dossier requirements: more papers, more trouble

In addition to the lengthy list of documents required for an automatic import license application under Circular No. 17, traders under Circular No. 24 must submit another two documents: one copy of the commercial invoice, and one original of a written bank payment certificate.

Under the earlier Circular No. 17, traders could stamp on the copy of the bank payment certificate and submit it to the licensing authority. The requirement of an original bank payment certificate removes such flexibility. It is not only time consuming, but also adds cost and time to traders while they apply for an automatic import license.

Submit application and receive license via post

All application dossiers must be addressed to licensing authorities via post, and all automatic import licenses and notifications about

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incompletion or invalidity of the trader's application dossier are also sent to the traders by post. This additional requirement creates a burden for enterprises. It is time-consuming to submit and receive the application by post, therefore costing the traders even more, especially in cases where the goods are shipped by air and only arrive in Vietnam one or two days after the date of shipment and traders have to pay extra fees for storing their goods at the airport due to the delay in automatic import license issuance. Moreover, the import registration dossiers or the documents sent to enterprises could be lost due to the unreliability of the postal service, and Government officials hold no responsibility in such a case.

Seven working days for the issuance of an automatic import license

For the issuance of an automatic import license, importers must wait for up to seven (07) working days (instead of five (05) working days in Circular No. 17) from the date of receipt of a trader's complete and valid dossier. An automatic import license is valid for thirty (30) days from the date of its certification.

Re-grant, modification and revocation of automatic import licenses

Circular No. 24 specifies that in case an automatic import license is lost or damaged, traders need to re-submit the dossier to the MOIT with a written explanation as to why they need the license reissued. The waiting period for re-issuance of licenses is five (05) working days.
