If disposing of more than one kilogram of lead....

Lead Waste:

- Any quantity of lead waste disposed of as regulated waste The Contractor has submitted a site-specific emergency П preparedness and response plan (EPRP) The EPRP includes provisions for spills/releases and fire Contractor personnel are familiar with hazards, the use of protective equipment and clothing procedures when handling waste containing lead Workers trained in lead safety П All lead containing waste is appropriately packaged for the waste waste category. For example, corrosive waste is stored in non-metallic containers All liquid waste containing lead stored in leak-proof containers with secure lid Lead waste not mixed with any other solid or liquid for the purposes of dilution Sign posted in temporary lead-storage areas All lead waste stored so that other wastes will have no contact. even if there is a spill Persons transporting or handing dangerous goods have valid and current Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) certification Contractor transporting lead waste has correct placard on vehicle П Emergency response kit on transportation vehicle Lead waste disposed of or recycled by a licensed waste П disposal facility Records П All inspections conducted on site
 - Copy of shipping documents for transportation of waste
 - Copy of disposal certificate from disposal facility
 - Copy of fire protection plan
